Pilot Initiatives as a Bridge Between Digital and Local Communities

As part of the development of the digital youth club *Cyberhus* at the Centre for Digital Youthcare, we have launched a series of pilot initiatives aimed at strengthening the connection between digital platforms and local communities. One of these initiatives is a workshop format tested at a local educational institution in one of our partner municipalities.

In the workshop, young participants engage with real-life dilemmas from Cyberhus, take on the role of a youth counselor, and share dilemmas from their own experiences. The purpose is to foster dialogue about youth vulnerability and to raise awareness of where young people can seek support when they find themselves in challenging situations.

Each workshop is systematically evaluated, and results show that more than 80% of participants so far have found the format both meaningful and useful.
