

Helpline early warning meetings

2026-2027

Early warning meetings for helplines take place every six weeks throughout the year.

The meetings provide an opportunity to share any information about possible emerging trends, concerns or issues that helplines are seeing within their own countries. This could include concerns about any apps, platforms or websites, any challenges (or successes) in reporting content as well as examples of media coverage about what children and young people are doing when they are online (risks and opportunities), any relevant research or policy/regulation. In addition, the meetings serve as a space for helplines to provide an update on any DSA related work that they are involved in. E.g. what is being done to promote the DSA in schools, how helplines are working with their DSCs, if helplines are or are planning to apply to be, trusted flaggers and any other progress being made with DSA tasks under their contracts.
